Applications

Application forms must be signed and accompanied with a deposit of £50. Deposits are non-refundable unless a recent doctor's or medical line can be given.

Conditions of payment

For Companies

Prior to candidates commencing the course, an appropriate letter of confirmation, together with Purchase Order or payment in full, must be supplied to Deaf Perspective.

For Individuals

All courses must be paid in full by the third week of the course. All ILA contributions will be administered following ILA funding and payment guidelines.

For Individuals: Payment Plan

Candidates wishing to pay fees in instalments using the Payment Plan must agree to Deaf Perspective's payment terms. Again all ILA contributions will be administered following ILA funding and payment guidelines.

Payment Default

Candidates who have not made or arranged payment prior to their agreed dates may be excluded from the course. In such cases, no refunds of any fees or deposits already paid will be made.

Cancellation & Withdrawal

For candidates wishing to cancel their course within one week prior to the course commencing, no refund on their deposit will be given, however they will not be expected to pay the full course fees. For candidates who leave the course after it has commenced, the full fee payment will be due within 28 days. Again, all ILA contributions will be administered following ILA funding and payment guidelines for cancellations.

Deaf Perspective will not cancel a class unless absolutely necessary. In such cases alternative classes will be offered. If this is unsuitable then a refund proportional to the time lost will be payable by Deaf Perspective.

Late Arrivals, Absence and Vacations

For candidates commencing their course after the first week, or who are absent during their course, no refund will be made. Periods will not be made up with a free extension of the course. However additional one to one sessions can be arranged for an appropriate fee.

Expulsion

Any candidate, who commits a criminal offence, is found guilty of gross or persistent misconduct in accordance with Deaf Perspective's disciplinary procedure will be excluded. No refund will be given.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Location

The property is located on Brand Street, Ibrox, Glasgow, half a mile from junctions 23 & 24 of the M8 Motorway. The City Centre is 5 minutes away (off-peak) and Glasgow Airport only 8 minutes away. Several bus services are available on Paisley Road West and the Cessnock underground station is a 2-minute walk from the centre.

Travelling westbound on the M8, continue towards Greenock. Take Junction 23 (Govan), at lights turn right, and continue through two sets of traffic lights. At roundabout turn right, pass Ibrox Stadium on left. Continue through lights, at junction turn left, take next left onto Midlock Street, and continue to end of road, turn right. The Festival Business Centre is the third building on the right.

Travelling eastbound on the M8, exit at junction 24 (the ASDA superstore), turn left and continue to the roundabout. Turn right, continue straight on through the next roundabout, past Ibrox Stadium, then as above, via Midlock Street.

The secure car park is reserved for the exclusive use of our tenants and is patrolled regularly. All guests are to park their vehicles on Brand Street adjacent to the building. This is monitored by our CCTV system.
